Plant Operator Recruitment

The San Andreas Sanitary District has a new opening for an exciting career opportunity. SASD is accepting applications for a full-time Plant Operator. The District will also consider part-time employment for applicants that are attending school. This position is on a career track, with an expectation of upward mobility and professional growth.

A Plant Operator at SASD performs a wide variety of technical tasks and is involved with many initiatives for environmental protection, such as ensuring compliance with State water quality requirements and with performing laboratory testing of the treated wastewater. Operators in San Andreas implement technical procedures for process control of the activated sludge treatment facility, interface with the plant's automation system, facilitate construction work with contractors, perform preventive and corrective maintenance, learn to operate heavy machinery, and provide plant tours for the local schools. This is a challenging and fulfilling career. A full job description is available for all the knowledge, skills, and abilities required.

Candidates need only a High School diploma or equivalent, and a valid California Driver's License to get started in this position. Of course, having related experience and/or having already completed education courses from community college or CSU-Sacramento is a plus.

The entry level wage is \$20.90/hr and progresses to \$41.42/hr based on experience, education, and certification. Benefits include CalPERS retirement, vacation days, and medical/dental insurance.
