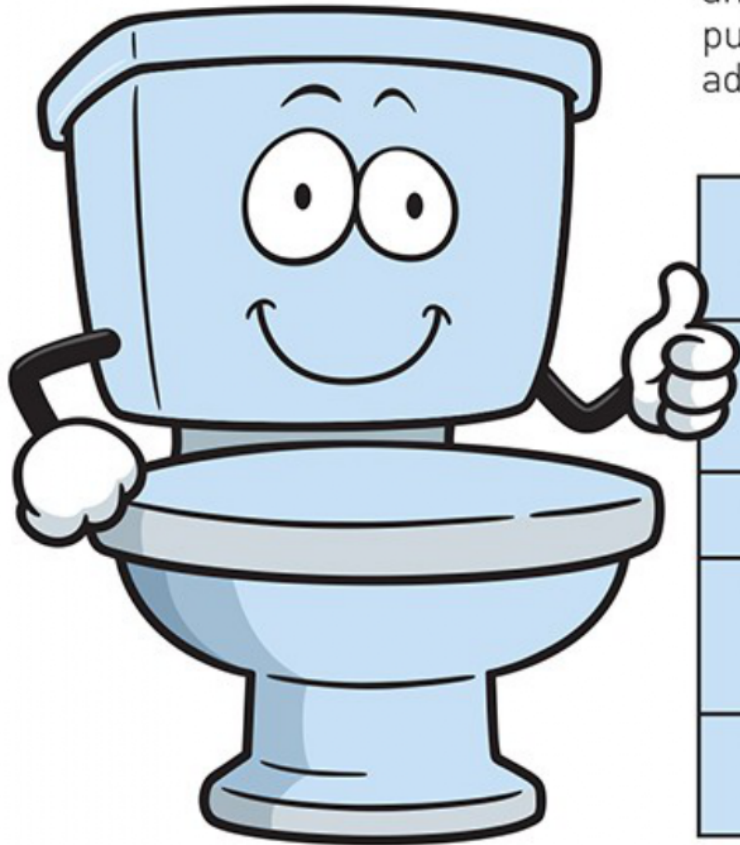




**San Andreas

Did you know?

San Andreas Sanitary District has an Ordinance that governs fair and consistent application of its regulations established to protect public health and our local watershed. One part of the Ordinance addresses the use of portable toilets.



DO

- Use portable toilets for a short-term use when a regular toilet is not available.
- Apply for a use permit at the District. Whether for a one-day party, community yard sale, or brief construction job, a permit is required.*
- Place only human waste in the portable toilet.
- Be courteous to neighbors. Keep the portable toilet in a discreet area, use odor masking and follow proper maintenance procedures.
- Remove toilet from your property at the end of permitted use.

DON'T

- Use a portable toilet as a substitute to toilets hooked up to the sanitary system.
- Skip the permit process or penalties will be imposed.
- Toss items including diapers, trash or other substances in the portable toilet.
- Skip maintenance or pumping schedules during use.
- Continue the use of portable toilets once construction has ended or the permit has expired.

Following these simple steps protects public health and safety, the environment and maintains the integrity of the sanitary sewer system. It's good for business, it's good for the community!
